Instruction **HAT**

Instruction **HAT** size: head circumference 54 cm



Materials from Gütermann

- Sew-all thread in a matching shade
- Cotton fabric 145 cm wide, collection COSY MOOD:
- 0.30 m summer flower pattern in red-green-white
- 0.30 m flower pattern in red and white
- 0.70 m grosgrain ribbon in pink, 15 mm wide

In addition

- 0.40 m fabric insert G 710, 90 cm wide
- 0.40 m fabric insert G 740, 90 cm wide
- Cut paper

Tools

- Sewing machine
- Iron
- Pressing cloth
- Scissors
- Pins
- Ruler
- Tape measure
- Textile marker or tailor's chalk

Preparation

Trace the cut pieces on cutting paper and cut them, be sure to not forget the threadline and the markings.

Cutting

- Summer flower pattern: 1x lid in the double fold, 2x side part in the fold, 2x brim in the fold
- Flower pattern: 1x lid in the double fold, 2x side part in the fold, 2x brim in the fold
- Fabric insert G 710 and G 740: each 1x cover in the double centre fold, 2x side part in the fold, 2x brim in the fold

Cut all parts, leaving 1 cm seam allowance.

Size variants

Head circumference approx. 52 cm: Cut the parts without seam allowance (with the exception of the lower side panels and brim).

Head circumference approx. 56 cm: Cut with 1 cm seam allowance, stitch the seams 0.5 cm wide.



1. Fix fabric insert G 740 on the back side of the summer flower fabric pieces. Place the coated side of the insert on the left side of the fabric, cover with a damp cloth and press in 12-second increments. Glue the flower fabric parts with G 710, the procedure is the same as previously described. After fixing in place, let the parts cool down for 30 minutes.



2. Place one brim and one side section of outer fabric between the markings B-B right to right and put them on each other. Stitch the seams. Trim the seam allowances and then press. Do the same for the second part. Lay the brim and sides right to right and pin along the straight edges A-B-C with needles. Stitch the seams, cut back the seam allowances and iron out. Carry out the same work steps on the inner hat with the flower pattern, leaving a slit in the middle of a connecting seam A-B-C.




3. Mark the quarter divisions of the lid with the iron or chalk. Put the upper edge of the brim of the outer hat right to right on the lid, taking note of the markings A and M. Stich the seam all around. Trim the seam allowances back and vertically. Press the seam allowances in the lid. Follow the same steps for the inner part of the hat.



4. Slide the inner hat right to right into the outer hat, all seams and markings overlap one another evenly. Pin the outer edges of the brim together. Sew the seam all around. Trim the seam allowances back and vertically. Turn the hat right side out through the slit in the hat lining. Flatten the crimped seam well, put it together and then press it. Close the slit in the inner hat with hand stitches.



5. Take the end of the 1 cm grosgrain ribbon and put it around the hat starting at point B. The band covers the seam of the brim side panel approx. 1-2 mm wide. Pin all around with needles, again cut the end 1 cm wide to the left side, so that the edges cover the seam. Sew on the beginning and end of the grosgrain ribbon, and stitch it in place at the quarter marks.



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
