



## White earrings

### Materials from Gütermann creativ

1 tube of Flower beads 5 mm Art. 639291 Col. 1005, 1 tube of Petal beads Art. 639290 Col. 1005, 4 Seed beads 9/0 Art. 612901 Col. 2525, 1 Pendant-mix in silver Art. 686310, 2 Fish hooks wires 15 mm x 25 mm in silver Art. 685917, Transparent thread 0.25 mm Art. 667765, Flat-nosed pliers Art. 670243, Round-nosed pliers Art. 670251, in addition: Jewellery glue

### Working instructions

Thread a total of 50 Flower beads (1 x white, 1 x transparent, alternating) to a string with Transparent thread. Thread a Flower bead at the end with both ends of the thread to close the string into a loop.

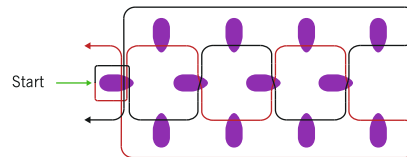
For the upper small flower thread 2 transparent Petal beads with each end of the thread. Then feed the right end of the thread through the next left bead and the left end of the thread through the next right bead to make a flower. Form the centre of the flower with one white Flower bead and one Seed bead (see sketch of small flower, steps 2 and 3). Finally feed the ends of the thread through the flower in such a way that they are opposite one another. Knot the threads and add a drop of adhesive. Feed the ends through two or three more beads to 'stitch' them before cutting off the excess.

For the large flower thread the beads to a ring with Transparent thread following the threading sketch. Before closing the ring lay the string around the loop at the centre base and only then cross the thread through the last bead (see sketch) in order to lock the ring into the loop. Form the centre of the flower with 1 Flower bead and one Seed bead (see sketch of small flower, steps 2 and 3). Then feed the ends of the thread through the beads in such a way that they are opposite one another, knot them together tightly and fix them in place with a drop of adhesive. Feed the ends through two or three more beads to 'stitch' them before cutting off the excess.

To hang the earring open the eyelet on the Fish hook wire using the Round- and Flat-nosed pliers, hang it in the centre of the upper flower between two 'Petals' and then close.

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# Necklace Boho

## Materials from Gütermann creativ

1 tube each of Flower beads 5 mm Art. 639291 Col. 5185, Col. 5280, Col. 5435, Col. 2775, 1 tube each of Petal beads 8 mm Art. 639290 Col. 5435, Col. 5280, 1 tube of Seed beads pearl 6/0 Art. 613762 Col. 5490, 3 Seed beads 9/0 Art. 773875 Col. 4965, 1 Pendant-mix in silver Art. 686310, 1 Coin-mix in silver Art. 686328, 1 Spring clasps 30 mm silver-plated Art. 686301, 4 Crimp beads silver-coloured Art. 667633, 3 Rings 5 mm silver-coloured Art. 677361, Nylon coated 0.4 mm Art. 667846, Transparent thread 0.25 mm Art. 667765, Wire cutters Art. 670260, Flat-nosed pliers Art. 670243, Round-nosed pliers Art. 670251, in addition: Jewellery glue

## Working instructions

Make 3 small flowers:

Thread 5 Petal beads, 1 Flower bead and 1 Seed bead (Art. 773875 in pink) onto Transparent thread (a 30 cm length for each) following the threading sketch. At the end feed the ends through beads in such a way that they are opposite one another. Knot the ends together and add a drop of glue. Feed through two or three more beads before cutting off the excess. Cut the wire to a length of 110 cm using the wire cutter. Thread the beads onto the wire following the threading instructions and add 2 crimp beads on each end. Thread the completed flowers between the beads as you wish.

Threading instructions for each repeat:

9 Flower beads in two different colours (e.g. 6 in lilac and 3 in pink), 1 Petal bead, 3 Flower beads, 1 Petal bead, 9 Flower beads (always in two different colours split into 6 and 3), 6 Seed beads, then start again from the beginning.

For the closure feed 11 Seed beads on one end and feed the end of the wire back through two Crimp beads so that it forms a loop. Fix the Crimp beads in place using the Flat-nosed pliers so that the beads on the loop are touching one another. Cut off the excess wire with the Wire cutter.

Before attaching the Spring clasps to the other end of the necklace attach the Pendant-mix (small coin, star and feather) anywhere along the necklace using a Ring. To do this bend one ring open using the Round-nosed pliers or Flat-nosed pliers, insert the pendant, hang the ring at any point on the Nylon coated between the beads and close the loop.

Finally thread on the large Spring clasps, thread the end of the wire through both Crimp beads, slide all the beads and Spring clasps together and fix the crimp beads in place using the Flat-nosed pliers before cutting off the excess with the Wire cutter.



## Tassel pendant

### Materials from Gütermann creativ

1 tube of Seed beads pearl 6/0 Art. 613762 Col. 5490, 1 tube of Petal beads Art. 639290 Col. 5435, 1 End cap 7 mm silver-coloured Art. 686298, Transparent thread 0.25 mm Art. 667765, 1 Spring clasps 15 mm silver-plated Art. 667536, Extra Strong M 782 Art. 724033 Col. 512, Braided ribbon 6 mm Art. 650226 col. 128, Flat-nosed pliers Art. 670243, Round-nosed pliers Art. 670251, in addition: Jewellery glue

### Working instructions

Undo the 3-part braid and continue with one section. Divide this into nine 20 cm pieces. Tie a knot in the end of each piece. Lay the nine pieces on top of one another and tie them together using Sewing thread Extra Strong. Fold the pieces in half and tie tightly below the fold to form a tassel. Knot the ends of the thread tightly.

Use Sewing thread Extra Strong, the Seed beads and one Petal bead for each 7 strings of beads as follows and attach this to the tassel: Cut off 70 cm of Sewing thread Extra Strong and first sew the thread to the upper end of the tassel with several stitches, then thread on 19 Seed beads and one Petal bead on the end. Feed the thread back through all 19 Seed beads, pull them tightly together so that the beads are close together and fix again at the upper end with stitches. Repeat this process a total of 7 times so that the strings of beads are evenly arranged. Stitch the thread at the end, cut off the excess, glue the end of the tassel into the end cap with a large drop of adhesive and leave to dry overnight.

To decorate the end cap thread the beads to a ring using Transparent thread following the threading sketch. Before completing the ring lay the string around the cap and only then pass the thread through the last bead (see sketch). Close the ring tightly around the cap. Thread the ends through the beads in such a way that they can be seen at the lower edge of the cap and are opposite one another. Tie the threads together tightly and fix them in place with a drop of adhesive.

Finally wrap the ends of the threads several times around the tassel along the edge of the cap, knot and fix in place with adhesive.

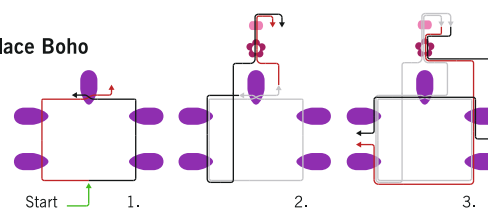
Attach the Spring clasps to the cap eyelet with the ring. To do this bend the ring open with the Round-nosed and Flat-nosed pliers, insert the Spring clasps and eyelet and close the ring.

## Large coin pendant

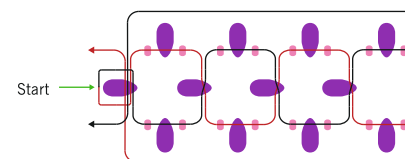
### Working instructions

Thread 11 Flower beads and the large coin using transparent thread. Feed the end of the thread back through all the Flower beads and attach the Spring clasps 15 mm. Knot the ends of the thread together, add a drop of adhesive and feed back through two or three beads again before cutting off the excess.
