



Working materials from Gütermann creativ (for lenght of 19 cm)
Tropic beads 11 x 8 mm, Art. 613584: 1 x in purple, Col. 5560,
1 x in purple Col. 5546, 1 x in grey, Col. 9675, 1 x in grey Col. 2525,
Clasp 8 mm silver Art. 677566, Seed beads pearl 6/0 Art. 613762:
78 x in lilac, Col. 5490, 62 x in beige, Col. 3010,
1.50 m Waxed cord in black Art. 684457,
additionally: 0.50 m lace velvet ribbon in light pink (Satab), super glue

#### Working instructions

Make 3 strands of beads: Thread the waxed cord through a hole in the velvet ribbon. Allow the ribbon ends to project 8 cm at the start. Thread a Tropic bead onto waxed cord and knot it together with the velvet ribbon straight after the bead. Thread 4 Seed beads pearl onto waxed cord in black, and then knot the waxed cord together with the velvet ribbon. Thread on and knot Tropic beads and Seed beads pearl alternately in this way until the required bracelet length has been reached or until all 4 Tropic beads have been used (the pattern should end with a Seed bead).

In addition, thread 62 Seed beads pearl onto two further strands on waxed cord, fixing both the beginnings and ends with knots. Lay all 3 bead strands flush next to each other. Knot the ends together and stick the clasp over them using super glue.

# Betty's necklade (Cover)

Working materials from Gütermann creativ (for lenght of 51 cm)
Seed beads pearl 6/0, Art. 613762: 350 x in silver, Col. 9525, 210 x in purple
Col. 5560, 280 x in lilac, Col. 5490, Nylon coated Ø 0.4 mm in steel
Art. 667846, 6 x Calottes 3 mm silver-plated, Art. 685992, 12 x Crimp beads
Ø 2 mm silver, Art. 667633, 2 x Clasp 8 mm in silver Art. 677566,
Round-nosed pliers Art. 670251, Flat-nosed pliers Art. 670243, Wire cutters
Art. 670260, also: Cotton fabrics, 0.25 m stripes in grey/light pink, 0.30 m
stripes in grey/beige, 1 button in grey Ø 23 mm, super glue.

#### Working instructions

Cut pieces of fabric (inc. 0.75 cm seam allowance) Part A (necklace)  $36 \times 22 \text{ cm}$  stripes  $1 \times 10^{10} \text{ x}$  x in grey/light pink, Part B (bow, cut diagonally to the run of the fabric) each  $54 \times 2.5 \text{ cm}$  stripes  $2 \times 10^{10} \text{ m}$  stripes  $2 \times 10^{10} \text{ m}$  grey/beige

**To sew** Fold Part A together along its length with the right sides facing, 0.75 cm in, the narrow sides should stay open. Turn the band of material, iron and cut in half. Gather the 4 band ends using hand stitches and adhere using super glue into one closure capsule each. Remove the snap hook or the extension chain on one half of each band of material. Pin Parts B with the right sides facing, and cut the ends off diagonally. Stitch the band all round from the centre 0.75 cm in, leaving a 5 cm-long turning slit in the centre. Trim any extra material, turn the band and iron it. Tie the band into a bow, which will also fix the slit. Sew the button onto the centre of the bow.

Making the necklace For the centre part of the necklace, thread up 3 bundles of 4 strands of Seed beads pearl each. Cut 12 x 30 cm each of Nylon coated using the wire cutters. Thread up 1 crimp bead each in bundles of 4 on Nylon coated, and fix after 2 cm with the flat-nosed pliers. Thread 1 calotte and 1 crimp bead each onto the 2 cm long nylon, flush in front of the crimp beads. Fix the crimp bead in the calotte, close the calotte with the flat-nosed pliers and cut off any projecting thread. Thread up 70 Seed beads pearl each onto a total of 12 strands. Distribute 5 strands in silver, 4 strands in lilac and 3 strands in purple irregularly onto the bundles of 4. At the end of the strands, fix 1 crimp bead flush after the last Seed bead pearl. Thread up 1 calotte with 1 crimp bead and close as at the start using the flat-nosed pliers. Hook the 3 bundles of beads into the bands of fabric with the calotte into a ring (without the snap hook or extension chain) of the clasp capsule and bend it shut using the Round-nosed pliers. Sew the fabric bow over a clasp part on the necklace with hand stitches.

Sew-all thread in matching colour, 1 Toggle fastener Art. 677523 silver, Nylon coated Ø 0.4mm Art. 667846 in steel, Crimp beads Ø 2 mm Art. 667633 silver, Calottes 3 mm Art. 685992 silver coated, 4 x 150 Seed beads pearl 6/o Art. 613762 in lilac: Col. 5490, Flat-nosed pliers Art. 670243, Wire cutter Art. 670260, Round-nosed pliers Art. 670251.

additionally: remnants of floral cotton fabric in grey/beige, 0.10 m waxed cord in purple, 25 mm wide, coverable button Ø 10 mm

# Working instructions

Cut pieces of fabric (incl. 1 cm seam allowance) Part A (bow) 10 x 12 cm floral cotton fabric in grey/beige Part B (band) corded ribbon in purple 8 cm

# Chain

Cut 4 lengths of nylon coated wire each 60 cm long with the wire cutter. At one end, fix all 4 strands after 5 cm with a crimp bead and flat-nosed pliers. Thread 1 calotte and 1 crimp bead onto the short end and fix the crimp bead in the calotte. If necessary, add a drop of super glue and close the calotte with flat-nosed pliers. Thread 150 seed beads onto each nylon thread, fix the end of each strand together with a crimp bead, and then fix using 1 calotte and 1 crimp bead, flush after the last seed bead (as at the beginning). Hook each closure into a calotte and bend over using roundnosed pliers.

### Bow

Fold the bow in half across its width, right sides facing, and top stitch 1 cm all the way round, leaving a short turning opening in the middle of the longitudinal edge. Trim away the extra material, turn and iron. Place the bow on the side of the necklace, wrap the band centrally around the bow and twist all 4 necklace strands. Turn in the extra material and sew over each other onto the back of the bow. Ruffle the front of the bow. Cover the button with fabric and sew it centrally into the band.
