



Superstar pendant (10 x10 cm)

Working materials from Güterman creativ

Sew-all thread in red, Sequins hologram Art. 613010 in black: Col.1000, in red: Col. 4295, in silver: Col. 1005, Seed beads Art. 773875 in blue/black: Col. 6690, in grey: Col. 9380, in red: Col. 4595, 1 Bag clip Art. 677450 in silver, additionally: Denim remnants, remnants of double-sided iron-on volume fleece HH650 (Freudenberg), 0.20 m taffeta ribbon, striped in red/white, stuffing, star template 10 cm

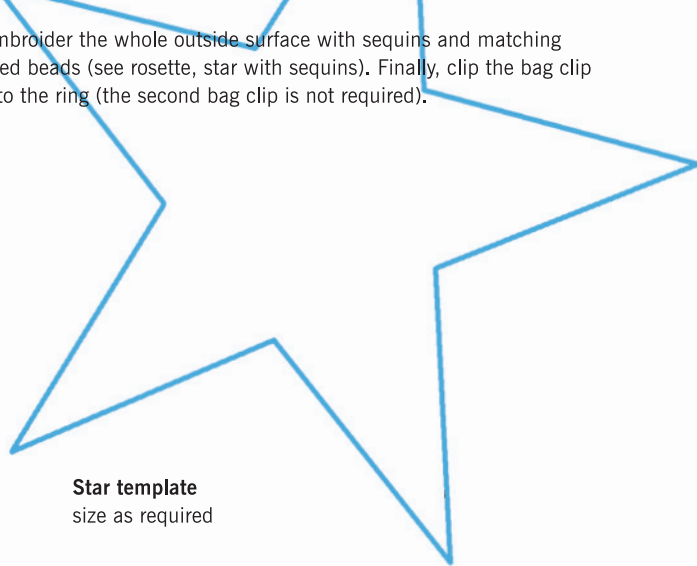
Working instructions

Cut pieces of fabric according to the pattern.
2 x stars from denim fabric and 1 x from volume fleece (3 mm smaller)

To sew

Fold the taffeta ribbon lengthwise in half and thread the snap hook onto it. Lay the denim stars, with the volume fleece in between, flush on top of each other with the wrong sides facing. Place the taffeta ribbon between the points of the star so that the ribbon with the ring projects out 4 cm over the point of the star. Iron down all layers. Top stitch the star all the way round close to the edge leaving a 3 cm opening, catching in the taffeta ribbon as you do so. Fill the star with a little stuffing and clean up all round.

Embroider the whole outside surface with sequins and matching seed beads (see rosette, star with sequins). Finally, clip the bag clip into the ring (the second bag clip is not required).

Hollywood bag (Cover)

Working materials from Gütermann creativ (approx. 27 x 41 cm)

Sew-all thread in red, Sequins hologram Art. 613010 in black: Col. 1000, in red: Col. 4295, in silver: Col. 1005, Seed beads Art. 773875 in blue/black: Col. 6690, in grey: Col. 9380, in red: Col. 4595, additionally: Used jeans (or denim shorts), 0,35 m striped cotton fabric in light blue/white, 150 cm wide (Westfalenstoffe), 0,35 m double-sided iron-on volume fleece HH 650, 150 cm wide (Freudenberg), star templates small 5 cm, large 9 cm.

Working instructions (The size of the bag depends on the size of the jeans.)

Cut pieces of fabric (incl. 1 cm seam allowance) Part A 1 x (upper material) jeans cut off at the crotch plus 1 cm seam allowance, Part B, lining 4 x from the striped fabric, 2 x from volume fleece. For the lining dimensions, measure the length and width of the cut-off jeans, add 7 cm to the height and 1 cm to each side of the width. Cut the lining and volume fleece accordingly. Part C (straps) 70 x 4 cm (2 x denim, 2 x striped fabric)

To sew All parts are sewn with sew-all thread in red. To create a used look, all seams and seam allowances should be visible from the outside. Clean up the cut edges with overlock stitch on the sewing machine or using an overlock machine.

Bag made from denim remnants Sew the bottom edge of the bag 1 cm wide with the right sides facing, and iron the extra material apart. To sew the corners of the bottom of the bag: With the right sides facing, fold the side seam from the corner onto the bottom seam of the bag. This creates a point. Measure 3,5 cm along the seam from the point, and draw a perpendicular line at this point. Top stitch along this line, and trim back the seam allowance 0.5 cm (see photo step).

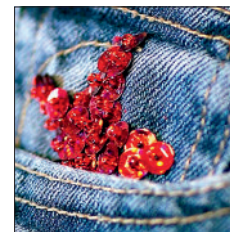
Bag Lining For each piece, lay the 2 lining parts, with the volume fleece in between, flush on top of each other with the wrong sides facing, and iron them together. Pin the lining parts together with the right sides facing, and top stitch the side and bottom seams 1 cm in. Iron the seam allowances. Clean up the seam allowances and the upper edge. Sew the corners together for the bottom of the bag lining (see upper material).

Handles For each strap, lay a piece of denim and a piece of striped fabric with the wrong sides facing flush on top of each other, top stitch together a machine foot width in and clean up all edges. Pin the strap ends centrally to the inside of the bag, 1 cm above the waistband seam and 16 cm apart. Top stitch along the waistband from the outside. Match the colour of the sew-all thread to the jeans seam thread. Push the lining into the denim bag and pin all the way round, with the seams flush one over the other. At the top, the lining should overlap approx. 6 cm for the cuff. Sew the lining from the right side along the top edge of the waistband of the jeans, leaving out the overlap and underlap of the fly and the belt loops.

Application For the sequin application, place and draw two stars (one large and one small) onto the denim bag according to the pattern. Embroider the stars with sequins and matching seed beads as you wish in red, black and silver. (see rosette, star with sequins).

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Tip:
you will need one pair of old jeans for all three patterns

Brooch Fame (Ø 10 cm) →

Working materials from Gütermann creativ

Sew-all thread in red, Extra Strong M782 in matching colour, Sequins hologram Art. 613010 in black: Col. 1000, in red: Col. 4295, in silver: Col. 1005, Seed beads Art. 773875 in blue/black: Col. 6690, in grey: Col. 9380, 1 Brooch pin Art. 677167 in silver: Col. 1001, additionally: remnants from a pair of old jeans, remnants of light blue/white striped cotton fabric (Westfalenstoffe), remnants of double-sided iron-on volume fleece HH 650 (Freudenberg), 0.35 m striped taffeta ribbon in red/white, 1.5 cm wide, star template 5 cm

Working instructions

Cut pieces of fabric (incl. 0.75 cm seam allowance) Part A 1 x (outer rosette) 39 x 6 cm from the trouser leg, outer longitudinal edge = hem edge of the jeans, Part B 1 x (inner rosette) 20.5 x 6 cm striped fabric, Part C 3 x (star) according to the pattern, 2 x denim fabric and 1 x volume fleece (3 mm smaller all the way round)

Sewing All parts are sewn with sew-all thread in red. To create a used look, all seams and seam allowances should be visible from the outside. Clean up the cut edges with overlock stitch on the sewing machine or using an overlock machine. Clean up part A along the longitudinal unhemmed edge. Pin the short edges together with the right sides facing, sew together into a ring with a 0.75 cm seam, cut away the extra material and clean all edges. Sew tacking stitches along the cleaned up edges with extra strong thread, ruffle into a rosette and sew down the threads. Iron part B half way along its length, with the wrong sides facing. Clean up the open longitudinal lengths. With the right sides facing, sew the narrow sides together 0.75 cm in and clean up the extra material. Tack along the fold, ruffle and sew down the threads. Sew part B onto the middle of part A so that all seam and hem edges are visible on the outside.

Making the star with sequins Lay the denim parts C with the volume fleece in between flush on top of each other with the wrong sides facing. Iron on the star and top stitch together close to the edge along the contours. Embroider the outside of the whole star with sequins and matching seed beads in black, silver and red. To do this, fix the sewing thread with a few stitches, thread up one sequin and one seed bead (matching colours), thread back through the sequin and sew the thread into the fabric again. Sew a row of sequins in black along the contour, cover the inner part of the star with silver sequins and sew a red sequin on in the centre. Fold the taffeta ribbon over in the middle, wrong side facing right side, so that the fold creates a standing loop, with the ends of the ribbon crossed. Pin the folded taffeta ribbon with the protruding loop centrally over the rosette and cover with the sequin star. Sew down all parts in the centre on top of each other, and then cut the taffeta ribbon diagonally. Sew the brooch pin onto the centre of the rear side.
