# Wrap Bracelet Blue Temptation

(Wrist circumference 17 cm)

Working materials by Gütermann creativ Clasp 8 mm Art. 677566 in silver, each 3.60 m wax cord in white Art. 685429 and blue Art. 685445, seed beads pearl 6/0 Art. 613762 168 x Col. 9525, HT2 textile glue Art. 613606

#### Instructions

Cut 4 strands, each 1.80 m long, 2 x in white, 2 x in blue. Knot all 4 strands together 10 cm from one end. Then, knot the strands according to the "Diagonal Rows" instructions. When doing so, place the cords so that there are two strands of white in the middle and a strand of blue on either side. First, knot a row in blue, then two rows in white, two rows in blue, and two in white, alternating. After knotting each strand, thread on two grey seed beads.

Then, continue working in the following pattern: Two rows of blue, two rows of white, two rows of blue, two rows of white, two seed beads on each strand. Repeat the pattern 3 times in total and, for the last repetition, thread 30 seed beads onto each strand.

Slide the beads close together and place the strands so that there are two blue strands at the left and then two white strands next to each other. Now, repeat the pattern above. Repeat the entire pattern for a total of four times until, after the fourth time after the second repetition of blue, knotting all strands together close to the end of the pattern. Cut off the excess thread on both ends. Glue the beginning and end knots into the respective cap with plenty of glue. Let dry overnight.

#### "Diagonal Rows" instruction

The easiest knotting technique, only requiring RR knots. The number of strands can be varied and determines the width of the piece of jewellery. Begin with the knotting thread at the outer left and knot an RR knot over each subsequent adjacent strand. The leftmost strand always determines the colour of the next row.





# Bracelet Pink Flavour

(Wrist circumference 17 cm)

Working materials by Gütermann creativ Clasp 8 mm Art. 677566 in silver, each 2.40 m wax cord in white Art. 685429, black Art. 684465 and pink Art. 685437, seed beads pearl 6/0 Art. 613762 144 x Col. 1016, HT2 textile glue Art. 613606

#### Instructions

Cut 6 strands, each 1.20 m long,  $2 \times in$  white,  $2 \times in$  black and  $2 \times in$  pink. Knot all 6 strands together 10 cm from one end. Attach the strands with a piece of tape or knot the end to a chair or similar. Then, knot the strands according to the "V-pattern facing up" instructions. When doing so, place the cords so that there are two strands of black in the middle, a strand of white next to each and a strand of pink on each outer side.


After knotting each V-pattern in pink, thread on a white seed pearl on every strand, then repeat the pattern three more times. Finally, for the middle part of each strand, thread on 18 white seed beads, then divide the six strands into three pairs of two and braid twice. When finished, place the strands so that they match the beginning: two black strands in the middle, two white strands on either side and two pink strands on the outside.

Slide the pearls together tightly and keep working with the strands according to the "V-pattern facing down" instructions. When doing so, after knotting each V-pattern in black, thread on a white seed bead on every strand. Repeat the pattern three more times, then do not thread on any more beads after the third repetition and knot all strands together close to the end of the pattern. Cut off the excess thread on both ends. Glue the beginning and end knots into the respective cap with plenty of glue. Let dry overnight.

**Tip:** To make it easier to thread on the seed beads, dip the ends of the wax threads into a drop of glue, cut at a diagonal with a pair of scissors and let dry briefly.




### Instructions for "V-pattern facing up"



Begin with the two middle strands and tie an RR knot. Then, tie two RR knots to the right and two LL knots to the left.

Repeat the pattern as often as you like, depending on the pattern, and always work from the middle outwards,


### Instructions for "RR knots"



The right thread is the guide thread and is held tightly when knotting. The left thread is the knotting thread and is placed over the guide thread from the left, placed around the guide thread and pulled tightly upwards and to the right.

Repeat this process again.


## Instructions for "V-pattern facing down"



Now, begin from the outside in. Work with two RR knots with the outermost left strand (knotting thread) and repeat in the opposite direction from the outermost right side, knotting two LL knots. Then, knot an RR knot with the two middle strands.

Repeat the pattern as often as you like, depending on the pattern, and always work from the outside in.

### Instructions for "LL knots"



The left thread is the guide thread, the right thread is the knotting thread.

Place the knotting thread from the right over the guide thread, place it around the guide thread and pull it tightly upwards to the left.

Repeat.

# Bracelet Green Desire



Working materials by Gütermann creativ 2.60 m wax cord each, in white Art. 685429, in beige Art. 684430 and in green Art. 685453, seed beads pearl 6/0 Art. 613762:  $52 \times Col. 1016$ ,  $52 \times Col. 9525$ ,  $48 \times Col. 8015$ , Loop bead Art. 619981,  $1 \times Col. 8320$ , HT2 textile glue Art. 613606

#### Instructions

Cut 6 strands, each 1.30 m long, 2 x in white, 2 x in green and 2 x in beige. Provisionally knot all 6 strands together 15 cm from one end. Then, knot the strands according to the "V-pattern facing up" instructions. When doing so. place the cords so that there are two strands of green in the middle, a strand of white next to each and a strand of beige on each outer side. First knot one row in green, one in white and one in beige. Directly after knotting each strand, thread on a white seed bead. Then, continue working in the following pattern: Knot one row in green, thread on a grey seed bead to each strand, one row of white, thread on a green seed bead to each strand, a row of beige, thread on a white seed bead to each strand. Repeat the pattern once more, then knot a row in green and thread on seed beads onto every strand according to the photo. Slide the beads close together and place the strands next to each other so that there are two white strands in the middle, a beige strand on either side and a green strand on each outer side. Continue to knot the strands according to the "V-pattern facing down" instructions. Beginning with the green, outer strand as the knotting thread, thread on a white seed bead to each strand after the knotted row.

Then, continue working in the following pattern: Knot one row in beige, thread on a green seed bead to each strand, one row of white, thread on a grey seed bead to each strand, a row of green, thread on a seed bead in white to each strand. Repeat the pattern once more, then knot a row in beige, one in white and one in green. For the variable closure, un-knot the temporary provisional knot. At both ends, thread on the remaining seed beads equally distributed and braid the strands together for a length of 4.5 cm. Thread the open ends opposite to each other through the Loop bead, knot the ends and cut off the excess thread.
